




## Creating a My BrainPOP Student Account

Students are able to join multiple classes with one My BrainPOP username.

| <p>1) Go to <a href="http://www.brainpop.com">www.brainpop.com</a> and click on the <b>Enter Code</b> button in the upper right hand corner of the screen.</p>   |    |
| <p>2) Enter the <b>Class Code</b>.</p>   |   |
| <p>3) If a student has already created a My BrainPOP account with another teacher, they should not create a new one. <b>They should sign in using their existing username.</b></p> <p>If a student does not yet have a username, click <b>Sign Up Now!</b></p> |  |

4) Students will select a **username** and **password**. If the username they choose is already in use, they'll receive an error message.

They'll also be prompted to enter their **first and last name**, and select a **security question** and **image** in case they forget their password.

Student accounts do not require entering an email address.

To finish creating an account, students must check the box agreeing to our **Terms of services** and **Privacy Policy**.
